

How to upload your images to the Museum's Flickr page:

If you already have a Flickr account:

Follow the link from the Museum's website to the Laurie Herrick Group Pool or use www.flickr.com/groups/laurieherrick. Click to join the group and add images.*

If you do **not** have a Flickr account:

1. Go to www.flickr.com
2. Set up your own Flickr account by clicking the "Create your Account" button. Follow the steps to set up your account using Gmail, Yahoo, or even Facebook.
3. Once you have your account set up and personalized, you can now upload images from your computer to your account by clicking "Upload Photos and Video" on your homepage.
4. After you have uploaded your images, select the drop down arrow next to "Groups" at the top of the page, click "Search for a Group", and type in "Laurie Herrick" to find the group (or use www.flickr.com/groups/laurieherrick).
5. When you find the group, "Laurie Herrick: Weaving Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow", click to look at it and join the group!
6. Finally, add your images to the "Group Pool" by simply clicking "Add photos" and following the steps.
7. Your images are now public!*

***Note:** If your Flickr account is new, first you need to upload at least 5 public photos (they don't need to all be linked to the Laurie Herrick Group Pool). After that minimum has been reached, then it shouldn't take more than a few days until your photos appear in searches, groups, etc. To make sure your photos show in searches, remember to add accurate tags and descriptions.
